

CrossLife Community Church Reopening Plan

Our Plan:

- Our first in-person service will be an outdoor service (weather permitting) on Sunday, May 24th at 10:30 am.
- Based on the recommendations by the state of Iowa, our services will be in the outdoor sanctuary (weather permitting) for the time being.
- We are only going to hold our morning service. There will be no Sunday School, no children's church, and no nursery until further notice. We will begin these ministries when we feel it is appropriate to do so.
- We are going to allow each small group to decide for themselves when they are comfortable resuming in-person meetings.

How we will keep people safe:

- We are temporarily shutting down the coffee bar and will not offer snacks.
- We are not going to offer printed bulletins for the service.
- We are going to mark off seating in the sanctuary (when we have indoor services) to maintain social distancing for all who attend.
- After indoor services, we will disinfect all surfaces to maintain a safe environment.
- We will have greeters at the entrances to open the doors, so attendees won't have to touch the door handles.
- We will have hand sanitizer for everyone attending the service to use.
- Do not shake hands, hug, or make physical contact with others attending. The vast majority of people who filled out our online survey indicated they are not comfortable with physical contact. You might not have a problem with it, but almost everyone else does.

Our Recommendations:

- Stay home and watch the service online if you are high risk, have an underlying health condition, have a fever, are sick, or are uncomfortable attending the service at this point.
- Please wear masks. We will not enforce this recommendation, but we strongly encourage everyone to wear masks.
- Do not fellowship in the foyer. When you arrive, please find a seat in the sanctuary. After the service, please exit the building. The size of our foyer makes it impossible to socially distance if we all hang around to fellowship.
